I must also reiterate that these coaches will also scout our juniors at the July School Holiday camp, to see which ones could step up towards having a trial and training experience with Atalanta BC's professional juniors in Italy later this year.

This is a real opportunity.


Trialling with Atalanta BC is only going to happen with the endorsement of Atalanta BC and Adelaide City officials.

Our impact also extends to the national stage. We have provided a pathway for several past and present Socceroos, Matildas, and a plethora of the best players to play in national competitions across Australia.
