It's an exciting time for our football club as Atalanta BC coaches flying in from Italy on July 16 signifies, we're very serious about junior development.

Headlined by Italy's Atalanta BC's academy coaches Luca Sbolli and Mattia Morelli and chief of the Oceania affiliation Domenico Gangemi, the trio will endeavour to give our children and budding coaches an Atalanta BC experience that they will cherish forever.

Sbolli, 28, is an ideal Atalanta BC coach for very young players and has nurtured future stars by winning major international youth tournaments.

Morelli, 22, is a young coach that is well versed in the Atalanta BC tradition and is connected to the prestigious Italian football school of opportunities.

Gangemi has inspired our club's junior arm since the first time he set foot in Adelaide last October as the club was in the process of locking down this historic affiliation.

Apart from leading our club's juniors and others to the first historic talent camp from July 18, at Oakden, the trio will spend their nights during the hectic week, coaching our Adelaide City underage sides as part of the affiliation agreement.

Our coaches will see first-hand what the professional Atalanta BC coaches can bring to this club.

Our juniors will be privileged in becoming the absolute first children to have this type of affiliation agreement in Australia with a foreign club.

I must also reiterate that these coaches will also scout our juniors at the July School Holiday camp, to see which ones could step up towards

having a trial and training experience with Atalanta BC's professional juniors in Italy later this year.

This is a real opportunity.

Trialling with Atalanta BC is only going to happen with the endorsement of Atalanta BC and Adelaide City officials.

I urge all children that are aiming to be on the bigger professional stage to take part in what Atalanta BC is bringing to Adelaide City in Australia during the school holidays.

Atalanta BC is the No. 1 development club in Italy and made the UEFA Champions League group stage with several of its very own academy graduates – 38 per cent of the squad just a few years ago.

Adelaide City has opened a real gateway door not only for our juniors but our coaches in this huge global football network.

This development project will continue to grow - only if it's validated by our very own people.

We beat Adelaide University in a WNPL clash and the cup round which sees us through to the semi final.

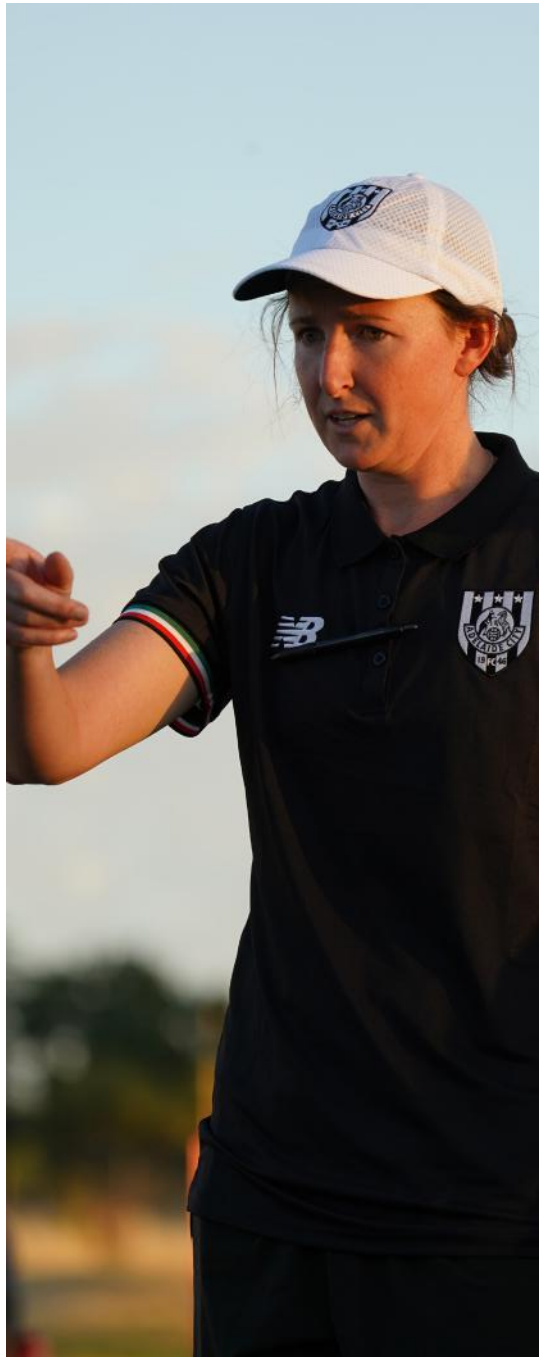
During this cup clash we created some good chances but couldn't find the back of the net until extra time where one of our young players Vicky Juma came on and netted the winner.

WHO ARE WE

Known as the Zebras, Adelaide City is a football club based in Adelaide, South Australia. The club played in the National Soccer League (NSL) for 27 seasons. We now play in the South Australian National Premier League (NPL SA). City was founded and is primarily followed by people of Italian heritage, originally called Juventus from 1946 to 1966. In 1966 we became Adelaide Juventus, and in 1977 Adelaide City, when Frank Lister captained the team in the inaugural Phillips NSL competition.

The club is one of the biggest across the NPL in Australia and arguably the most prominent in South Australia.

Several past and present players, coaches, and administrators of the Black and White have been inducted into the Football South Australia Hall of Fame.

Our impact also extends to the national stage. We have provided a pathway for several past and present Socceroos, Matildas, and a plethora of the best players to play in national competitions across Australia.

Adelaide City also boasts a strong women's program. We pride ourselves on offering the best facilities, quality coaching, and dedicated volunteers for all of our junior and senior programs.
