As we approach our first home game at Adelaide City Park, our Women's program continues to thrive across all levels, showcasing the strength and growth of female football within our club.


Stay tuned for more updates as we embark on what promises to be an exciting season for women's football at Adelaide City FC!





WHO WE ARE

Known as the Zebras, Adelaide City is a football club based in Adelaide, South Australia. The club played in the National Soccer League (NSL) for 27 seasons.

We now play in the South Australian National Premier League (NPL SA).

City was founded and is primarily followed by people of Italian heritage, originally called Juventus from 1946 to 1966.

In 1966 we became Adelaide Juventus, and in 1977 Adelaide City, when Frank Lister captained the team in the inaugural Phillips NSL competition.
